#### **Attendance**

Well done to our current Year 6, for the most improved attendance in the whole school. They finished last year with 90.8% attendance (which was a real concern), but they are currently running at 94.2%. Although still lower than we would like, this is a massive improvement. Our biggest concern now is Year 1, where attendance, at 89.3%, is in need of drastic improvement. After half-term we will send out colour coded attendance reports for all children. If your child gets a red letter, it is vital that we see some improvement. Please remember also, that if you take your child out of school to travel for 5 days or more, this will result in a fine.
