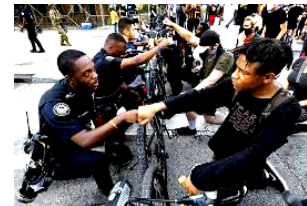
The feedback for last week on Class Dojo shown here is great – we are really pleased that it is proving useful.
